Dear parents and carers,

It has been quite an emotional week so I feel I should begin with the sad news of the passing of our lovely cook, Sam. Sam was diagnosed only a couple of months ago with Leukaemia and was admitted to hospital. We were all hoping for full recovery but unfortunately, she had a turn for the worse and developed an infection which she could not recover from. She passed away quietly last Friday evening. Sam was such a kind and considerate lady, she always made sure the children were happy and she was always conscientious and hard working. We are all really sad and shocked at her passing. She will be sadly missed and our hearts go out to her children and wider family.

On the last day of the school term (Tuesday 24th July) we would like children to come into school in non-school uniform and bring a small donation as we would like to have a pagoda and bench built in honour of Sam so this wonderful woman is always with us. Some parents and children already know this awful news as they live close to Sam or know the family but some don't. I have, therefore, shared the news with each class today and had a little discussion with them so please check in with them tonight and check they're

fine.


