MESSAGE FROM MISS BLACKBURN

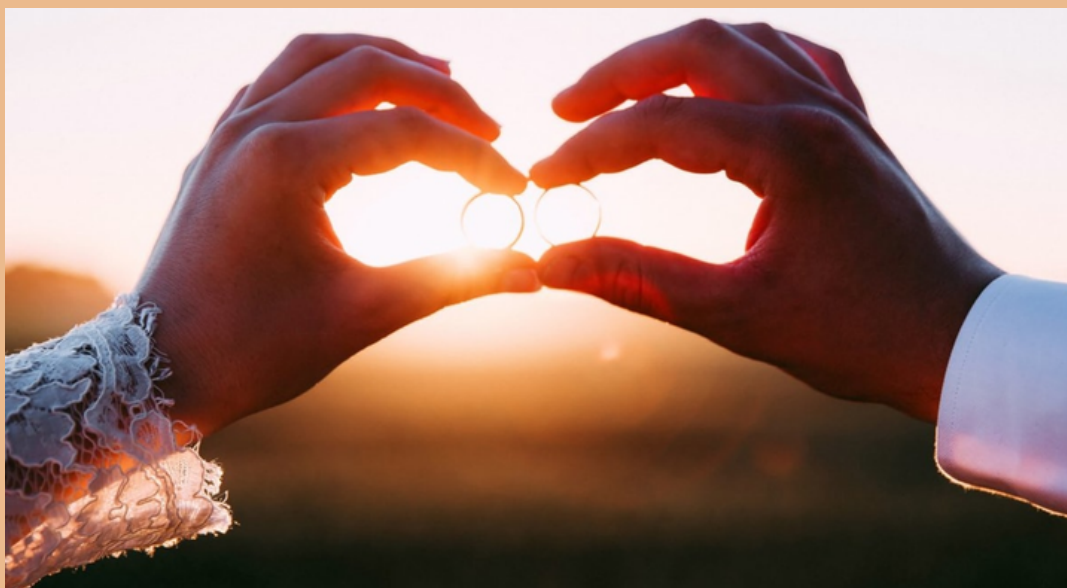
Dear parents/carers,

PUNCTUALITY AND UNIFORM

We have noticed these past few weeks, since Easter, that time keeping is slipping. Please can everyone ensure their child is here by 8:45 KS2 and 9am KS1.

Please also ensure your child is dressed in suitable school uniform; again we have seen that uniforms have been less consistent these past few weeks.

COST OF LIVING PAYMENTS FOR BENEFITS RELATED FAMILIES

The Department for Work and Pensions Household Support Fund has made available to families this year £160 per pupil from Reception to Year 11. This money will go to families of children eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals.

This support will be split across 2 payments of £80, one made in June and another in November.

The June payment will arrive in form of payment codes which families can take to a Post Office to exchange for cash.

Schools have been asked to distribute those payment codes. It is likely the codes will arrive early June. As soon as we receive those codes, and are back in school after the break, we will distribute them to your child.

PASTY DAY! LAST DAY OF TERM!

We will be serving steak or cheese pasties on the last day of term, Friday 26th May. We will also be serving meat or vegan sausage rolls.

If you would like your child to participate in pasty day, but they are unable to eat any of the above due to dietary restrictions, please feel free to bring in a suitable pasty for your child – and we will heat it up for them.

Community Event: CPR Training

Role 1 Medical have been working closely with us over the past 12 months to deliver basic CPR training to all students at Helston Community College.

There are around 60,000 cases of suspected cardiac arrest every year, but fewer than 1 in 10 people survive an out of hospital cardiac arrest.

With adequate training, immediate initiation of CPR can double or quadruple survival from out of hospital cardiac arrest. And defibrillation within 3-5 minutes of collapse can produce survival rates up to 50 – 70%.

Role 1 Medical would now like to offer CPR training to all parents/carers and the wider Helston community. As such, we are hosting a training event on Wednesday 14 June 2023 between 6.00pm and 7.00pm in the North Site Main Hall of Helston Community College.

The training costs as little as £8.00 per person to be trained by Paramedics that operate on the frontline

daily.

To make payment, please bring £8.00 cash to this event and pay Role 1 Medical directly.
