

Computing

We will be looking at using computing for communication and will use Seesaw to communicate our learning.

DT

We will focus on investigating using textiles in design. This could lead to flags or bunting or even a collage story.

Maths

We will learn about directional language and pattern which will help us follow instructions to find pirate treasure. We will continue to learn about the properties of 2d and 3d shapes and use them in pattern and find out how direction changes them. We will finish the term solving subtraction and addition problems using two two-digit numbers and analysing data and statistics.

PSHE/RSE

We will investigate how our bodies change and how they stay the same as we grow.

PE

We will begin with athletics, looking at both track and field events before rehearsing for Sports day. After that, we will be investigating which skills are needed to play cricket.

How does our coast shape our stories?

Inquiry

Our inquiry will have a geography focus. We will inquire into what our coast is like and how it is used. We will be practising and developing our mapping skills while embedding the geographical language we have been learning all year. We will think about how our coast shapes our stories. We will of course have to feature pirates and there will be opportunities to dress and talk like a pirate!

RE

We will be finding out what makes some people and places special. We will investigate buildings and other sacred places globally before focusing on Cornwall and looking at what might be special or sacred to people within our county.

Music

We will be transcribing and performing sea shanties to compliment the pirate theme.

Science

We will be finding out how the Earth's movement in space affects our seasons, day length and weather. Our investigations may lead to our own weather forecasts.

English

In English this term, we will be learning how to write adventure stories set on the Cornish coast. We will draw on our own experiences for setting, and on our class texts 'Treasure Island', 'Adventure Island' and 'Captured!' for inspiration for characters and plot. We will be embedding and celebrating our oracy skills during Oracy Week and through the rehearsals and performance of our Summer Production. We will, of course, be enjoying a poem a day.
